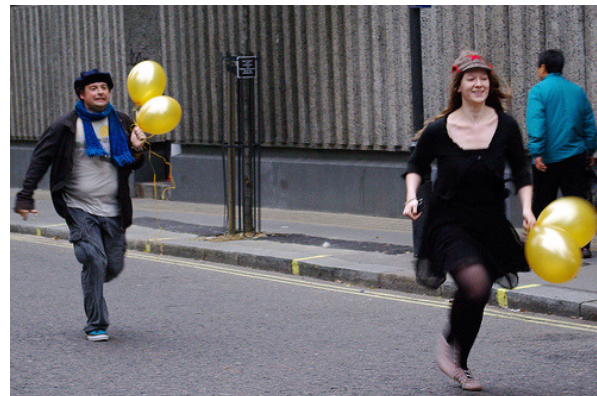

An artist-led programme of original commissions is transforming Kensington and Chelsea this summer

Following last year's impressive debut, InTRANSIT festival has returned with an exciting line-up of unique commissions organised by the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea Arts Service. Running until 21st August, the diverse programme is an exploration of both renowned and unusual spaces in Kensington and Chelsea, challenging our perception of the cityscape and allowing all ages to take part in a number of interactive experiences for free. 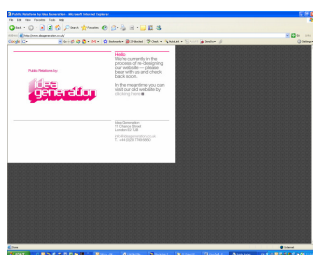

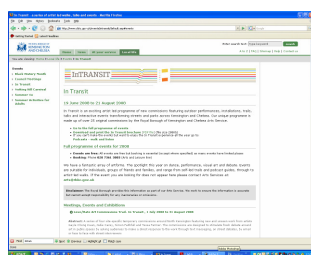
